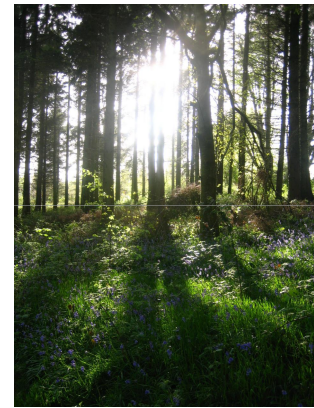


Spaxton Parish Council – Meeting AGENDA
