4.	New Planning Application: 45/07/00022/BAK: Cannington Cold Stores Ltd: The erection of buildings and plant for refrigeration building and associated biogas plant to produce electricity. The Vice Chairman said the extraordinary meeting had been called to give councillors and the public ample time to examine the extensive documentation attached to the application and discuss the proposed development. Mr Roe and Mr McDonald were happy to answer questions.
